Evacuation Drill-REMINDER

On Friday, October 21st, we will be conducting our mandatory evacuation drill. Any adult, including parents, needs to be listed on the Emergency Release Yellow Card and MUST bring ID with them. Parking will be off-site on the surrounding streets of Dayton, Juniper and Manor. All adults will need to walk onto campus towards the back parking lot.

There will be two lines to help the pick up process run more smoothly. To begin, go to the table and complete the release form, then to the ID check line. Once your ID is verified, you will move to the student release line. (Signs will be posted on the fence for easy visibility). After your student is released, please exit the campus immediately as if it were a real emergency, so that others can find parking. We are asking for your patience and cooperation during the release process.

Pre-K students will be released at 11:50 with their siblings. Students in K-8th please follow the schedule below. (Please arrive at your assigned time).

There will be NO Falcon's Nest available.

For K-8th, pick-up times are alphabetical. Please pick up your student based on their last name. If you are picking up additional students with a different last name, you will pick them up at the assigned time for *your* student.

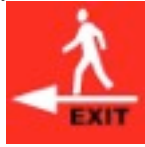

Scholastic Book Fair

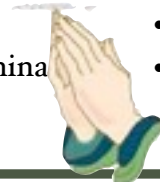

This is a reminder that on Friday, October 21st, we will be conducting our mandatory evacuation drill. Any adult, including parents, needs to be listed on the Emergency Release Yellow Card and must bring ID with them. Parking will be off-site on the surrounding streets of Dayton, Juniper, and Manor and the adult will need to walk onto our campus. There will be two lines to help the pick up process run smoother. After you fill out the Release Form at Step 1, you will line up at Step 2, which is the ID, check line. Once your ID is checked, you will head to Step 3, which is the student release line. (Signs will be posted on fence for easy visibility). After your student is released, please immediately leave so that others can find parking. We are asking for your patience and cooperation during the release process. Student release will begin at 11:50am. (Please arrive at your assigned time).

There will be no afternoon Falcon's Nest available.

Attention Preschool parents and guardians: Your pick up time will be at 11:50am. Please plan to pick up your preschooler and any older siblings at 11:50am.
